Planting and Maintenance of Biodiversity

At Cheriton Treehouse we actively help support and promote biodiversity within our business. The large pond, built by Dorset Aquatics, supports a wide range of biodiversity, from ducks and their ducklings to our pair of silver birch trees. The pond is reviewed by specialists every 3 or 4 months. We also selectively mow the grass on the banks of the pond creating areas for natural plants to grow allowing the process of natural succession to occur - from the pond up to the gardens of the main house.

A member of staff monitors the impact of the planting and the wildlife every day. Our gardener comes in regularly to maintain the pond, the grasses and the landscape in general.
